



ARRL ARES 2M Net Control Script



“Good evening and welcome to the Warrensburg Area Amateur Radio Club ARRL/ARES 2-meter net. This net meets each Sunday at 8:30 p.m. local, with its purpose being to promote fellowship among radio amateurs, and as a means of preparing us for emergency situations.”

- **PAUSE**

“It is my pleasure to welcome everyone to the net this evening. Your net control is _____. My name is _____ and I am located in _____.”

- **PAUSE**

“Let’s begin with any stations with formal traffic or club announcements, please call now.”
(Note announcements for concluding the net.)

“Are there are any mobile or short-time stations wishing to check in, please call _____.”
(Stations checking in/out, get their Name and Home Location for the log.)

After all mobile stations have made comments, proceed with normal check-ins. Process is the same as before. Recognize each station and ask for their comments (if any) in the order they checked in.

“I will now take any Echolink stations wishing to check in. Please allow a short pause before speaking to allow the controllers to link and your voice to come through in full. Echolink stations come now, this is _____.”

“Let’s move on to check ins from any station anywhere, please call _____.”

***** Net Control Response Recommendations*****

- ✓ Recognize the stations in order of check in.
- ✓ Signal report
- ✓ Respond to comments from caller and wish them a great day and a thank you for supporting the net.
- ✓ Identify often: This is _____, net control for this evening, and this is your chance to check in!

As you exhaust the list, make calls for additional check-ins. Recognize them and repeat the process as needed. After you call for check-ins a couple of times and there are no more, it’s time to conclude the net.

Repeat the announcements and make any additional announcements if needed. Give the club address and web site
