*For those new to amateur radio nets; here are a few things to remember:

- All licensed amateurs are welcome, no club membership needed
- Emergency traffic has precedence over all other traffic
- Nets are informal, however, following net control's guidance is generally expected
- "short time stations" are stations with limited time for the net
- "stations" are licensed amateur radio operators
- When you check into the net you will be given an opportunity to give your comments
- Your comments can be anything that is legal to say on the air
- If you are listening to the net on radio reference you can check in with Cary (KB0HV) via Facebook or text
